Autodesk Inc. (NYSE: ADSK) acquired AutoCAD in 1999 for \$15.5 billion. The previous owner of the original AutoCAD system was a consortium of companies including Corel, Intergraph and Seybold, who had acquired Solid Works Corporation and its subsidiaries in 1995 for \$1.65 billion. Since the acquisition of AutoCAD by Autodesk, the product has developed into one of the most widely used CAD software applications on the market. There are currently two types of AutoCAD software available: a desktop application (AutoCAD LT) and a subscription-based web application (AutoCAD Web).

1. What Is AutoCAD? AutoCAD is a desktop-based 3D computer-aided design (CAD) software application. AutoCAD LT for Windows users can be used to create 2D and 3D drawings, charts, and other visualizations. Autodesk provides two variants of AutoCAD: AutoCAD LT and AutoCAD standard. AutoCAD LT is a free version of AutoCAD that only runs on 32-bit and 64-bit Windows operating systems. AutoCAD standard is a high-end version of the software that requires the purchase of an annual license. It can be used on all Windows operating systems, including Windows XP, Vista, 7, and 8. It has both a desktop and online version. AutoCAD LT allows users to create drawings, charts, and other visualizations. It is used mainly for designing 2D or 3D architectural and engineering drawings. AutoCAD can also be used to create charts for Microsoft Excel, PowerPoint, and other Office apps. It offers a limited number of features that allow for the creation of workflows and macros. The functionality of AutoCAD LT and standard AutoCAD differs slightly, but both versions offer similar capabilities. The main difference between the two versions of AutoCAD is that AutoCAD LT runs on computers with 32-bit and 64-bit processors, while AutoCAD standard only runs on computers with 64-bit processors. **XML** The native XML file format is ASCII-based and is stored in the native format (i.e., not human readable). There are several alternative methods for exporting CAD drawings in XML format: Export to E-mail There are special functions in AutoCAD 2010 to export parts of the model as e-mail messages. This allows the designer to send the drawing to other designers who can open and view the drawing in the proper application and provide comments and suggestions to the original designer.

**Export to AutoCAD® Inventor format** Drawings can be exported to the widely used drawing format Inventor from within AutoCAD. **Printer** The native drawing format is used in Windows and supports printing natively using the Windows print system. AutoCAD supports two file extensions for drawings; DXF (Direct X Format) and DWG (Drawing Interchange Format) which are used for documents. For many CAD programs (such as SolidWorks and CATIA) it is possible to import DWG files directly, although the DWG format is not native to AutoCAD. Some CAD programs that use AutoCAD natively for their native format can import CAD DWG files and export CAD DXF files. CAD programs that do not natively support AutoCAD DWG files or import CAD DXF files may only have a limited import and export feature, and so may require a third-party converter to convert AutoCAD drawings into other CAD native formats. Many CAD programs provide external applications which can perform conversions.
